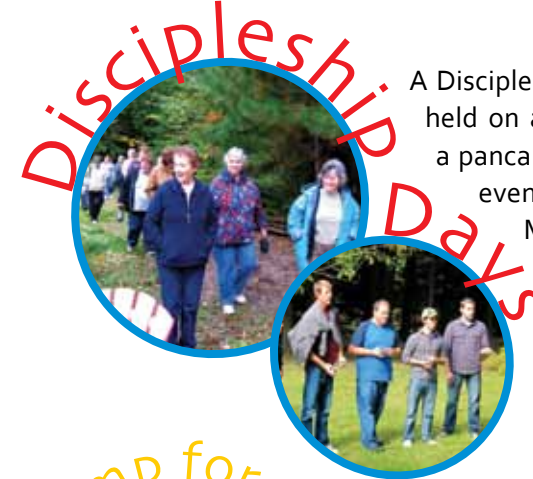


### Chuck Pierpont • Speaker for The ROCK

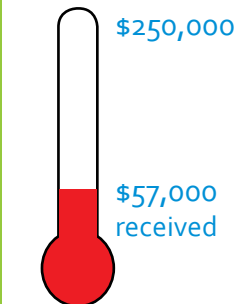


The building will expand the activities of the camp considerably and make year round camping possible. It will also permit us to serve the community with a variety of year round activities.

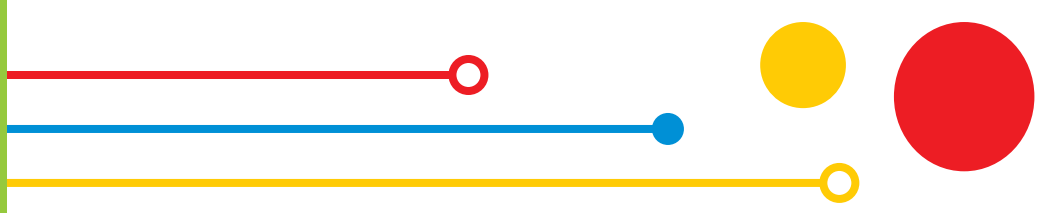
### Janine Nadjiwon • Food Services Manager

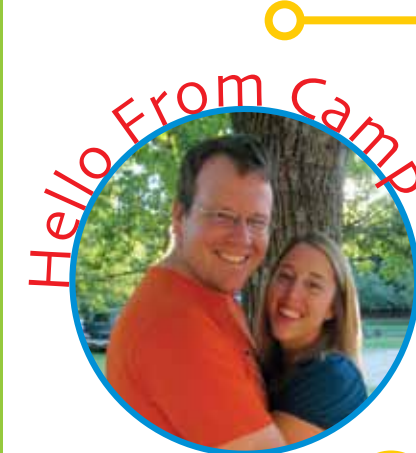
### Marsena Henderson • Summer Program Director

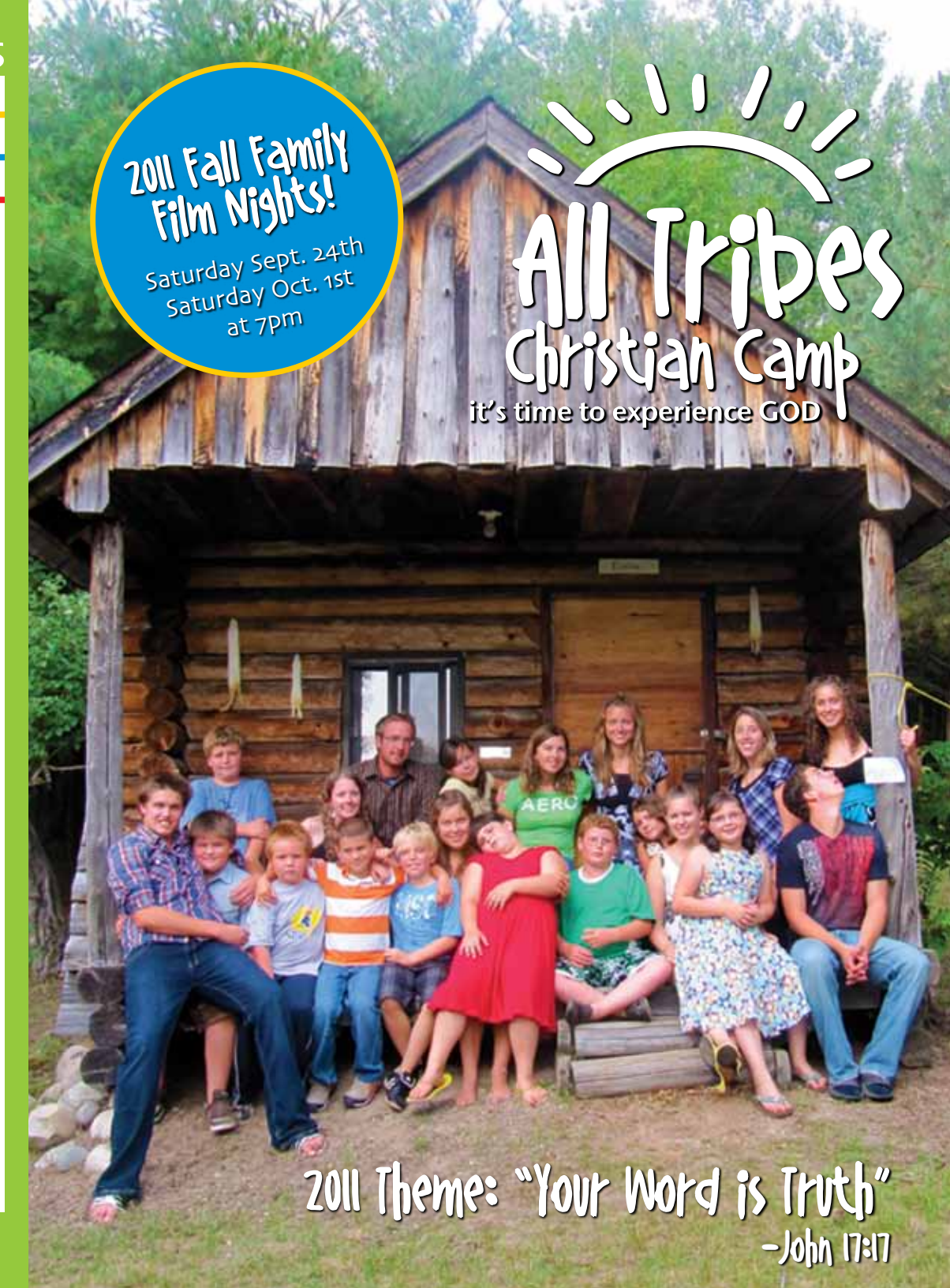
